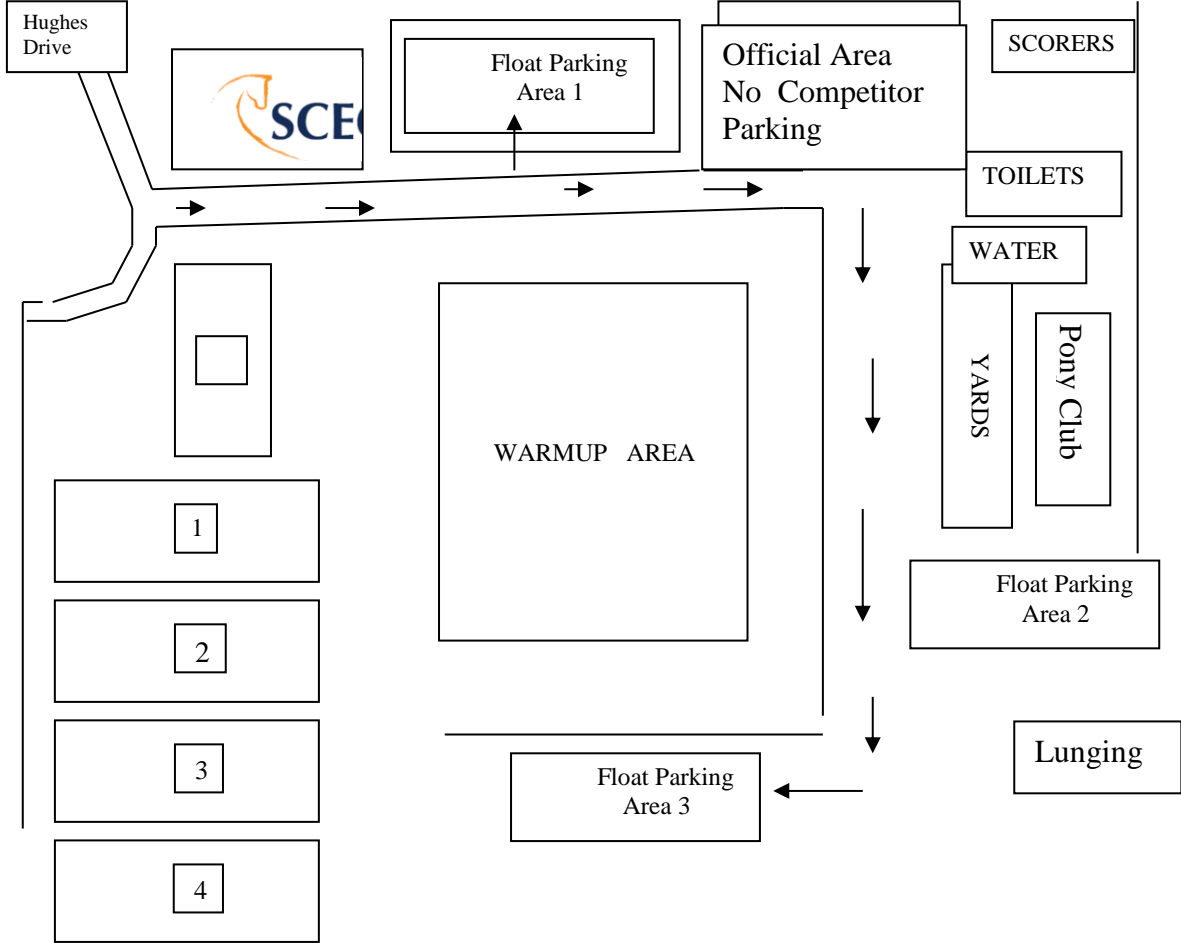
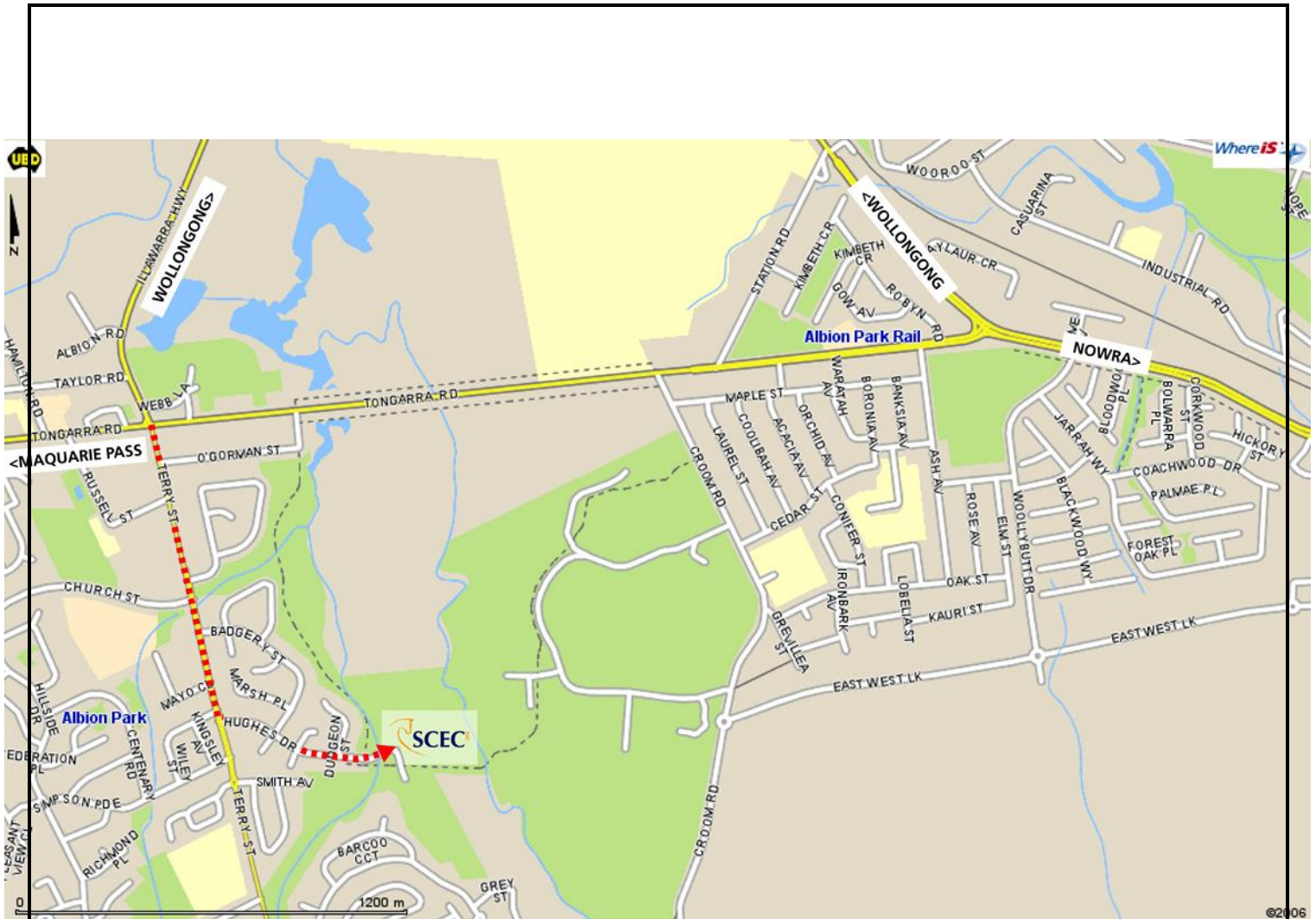

RULES OF COMPETITION

South Coast Equestrian Club competitions will be run in accordance with the EA Dressage Competition Rules and Procedures (July 2016).

Please pay particular reference to:

- Horses may only compete in 2 consecutive levels – eg Prelim/Novice.
- Horses are restricted to 3 tests per day.
- Ponies must not exceed 149cm (with shoes, 148cm without shoes) and may compete in associate or Official Pony.
- Juniors can compete in Junior events until the end of the year they turn 16.
- Times will be strictly adhered to. Failure to report to the judge at the allocated time may result in elimination.
- Dress and footwear as per Section 2 EFA Rules.
- Riders under 18 must wear Australian Standards helmets. Riders over 18 – as per rule book Section 2.2.
- Whips must not exceed 1.2m (horse); 1.0m (pony). Gloves must be worn in all tests.
- Horses may only be ridden by the designated competitor on the day.

The EFA rules are updated from time to time. A complete set of rules is available from the EFA or downloadable from the EFA website - www.equestrian.org.au. It is the responsibility of all competitors to be familiar with the rules and update their rulebook regularly.

- Neither organisers nor the owner of the grounds accepts any liability for any accidents, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or other persons or property whatsoever.
- Only horses entered in the competition are allowed on the grounds.
- All horses must be under the control of a competent handler. The handlers of horses exhibiting behaviour posing a danger to other horses, competitors or spectators may be asked to remove their horse from the grounds. Stallions must be controlled with a suitable restraining bit and head collar whilst being led.
- Strictly no lunging in warm up area. Lunging is to be performed only in the designated area.
- Riders are eligible to compete in Open, Junior or Open pony categories but are restricted to one category per horse.
- Ribbons will be awarded to third place then one in every four competitors to 6th place.
- Test papers can only be collected once the last score from the test has been entered onto the scoreboard and the placings calculated. Official tests cannot be collected until the judge has checked and signed the score sheets.
- Instructors may only instruct from the side of the warm up arena.
- Competitors must report to the gear steward before riding each test and no earlier than 10 minutes before the test.
- In the interest of safety for animals and competitors – all dogs must be kept securely on a leash at all times.

Risk Warning and Disclaimer

- Horse riding is a dangerous activity and can result in serious injury (including death) and loss.
- All persons who ride, or tend, a horse on these grounds do so entirely at their own risk.
- Neither the EA, SCEC, nor the Committee or any member thereof, accepts any liability for any personal injury (including death) suffered by any person from or relating to any incident involving a horse and whether or not caused or contributed to by the negligent act, error or omission of SCEC, the Committee or a member thereof.

RULES OF CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Winner and runner up will be awarded to the winners of each test/category (eg. Preliminary 1C official, official pony, associate, junior, pony = 5 classes and thus 5 winners).
- Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to each level (eg. Prep, Preliminary, Novice, Elementary, Medium, Advanced, FEI). ***Note the results from all classes (Official, Official Pony, Associate, Pony & Junior) will be combined in calculating each level's Champion and Reserve Champion.***
- Champion and Reserve Champion Horse will be awarded. Eligible results across all levels (Prep – Grand Prix) will be combined to calculate the winners. Horse riders must nominate the category in which they wish to compete – if a rider enters a Pony or Junior class (Official or Associate) that result will not be used in calculation of the Champion & Reserve Horse award.
- Champion and Reserve Champion Pony will be awarded. Eligible results across all levels (Prep – Grand Prix) will be combined to calculate the winners. Pony riders must nominate the category in which they wish to compete – if a rider enters a Horse or Junior class (Official or Associate) that result will not be used in calculation of the Champion & Reserve Pony award.
- Champion and Reserve Champion Junior will be awarded. Eligible results across all levels (Prep – Grand Prix) will be combined to calculate the winners. Junior riders must nominate the category in which they wish to compete – if a rider enters a Horse or Pony class (Official or Associate) that result will not be used in calculation of the Champion & Reserve Junior award.
- Official and Associate scores **above 55%** for each of 2 tests at the same level are ranked together to provide championship points (30 for the highest score, 29 for the next, etc).
- Where a competitor rides 3 tests at any level (official and associate in the same test, eg Preliminary 1C), the better score achieved in that test will count for award calculation.
- The Graeme Swan Memorial trophy and prize will be awarded to the horse and rider achieving the highest % score (eg 76%) at the Championships in an Open test Preliminary and above.
- The Figtree Pony Stud trophy and prize will be awarded to the horse and rider achieving the highest % score (eg 76%) at the Championships in a Junior test.

The Prize Giving Ceremony will commence at approximately 3.00pm

A photographer will be present. Winners and runners up should be prepared to present themselves in competition attire for the ceremony.
