## From the President January 2010

Welcome to the first newsletter from SCEC for 2010. Most of the rest of the committee have also retained their places, and as a new addition we sincerely welcome Caroline Morley to the committee (Caroline has kindly agreed to take on the Judges Convenor job for the year, and has already jumped straight in, working hard at sourcing judges for at least our first couple of competitions this year). I'm sure you will all join me in welcoming in all the new committee, and thanking them for taking on the role ... the existence of SCEC would not be possible without the (sometimes substantive) commitment of these people. Your committee members contact details are listed in this newsletter and on our website, please feel free to contact any one of us if you have ideas or issues you wish to share.

To begin the year we are holding a Training Day on Sunday 21 February,

2 weeks before our first comp for the year on Sunday 7 March. Details and entry forms for both these events can be found in this newsletter.

As well as our normal 6 comps and a couple of training days your committee have already sourced 2 top level coaches to come down and run clinics for members. The first of these is Brett Parbery and will be held on Sunday 4 April ... and yes I know that's Easter Sunday (but true horse people don't go away for Easter !!!), with Brett also agreeing to provide a talk the evening before (Saturday evening 3 April). Details about the venue for the Saturday evening will be provided closer to the date. Entry to the clinic will open approx 2 weeks prior ... and going on our experience last time, places will fill up very fast !! Even if you are one of the unlucky ones and don't get a place, do come and watch, as this in itself is quite instructive.

Running competition days requires input from many people ... and we ask that all our members volunteer to help with one task or another as often as they possibly can, especially on competition days ... helping set up the grounds, penciling, collecting tests are just some of the myriad of tasks that we need help with. This year, we'll be especially encouraging the juniors to

have a go at penciling ... sitting with a judge and seeing how tests flow from their perspective is a great experience and can help a rider finesse the riding of their own tests to ensure the best possible reception from the judge. So please don't be backward in coming forward and offering to help with whatever you can.

This year SCEC committee meetings will be held on the Wednesday a week and a half before each comp – that is, the committee will meet 6 times during the year (and probably an extra at the end of the year to sort out HOTY/point score etc), rather than each month. All members are welcome and we encourage anyone who may have ideas, suggestions or just a general interest in what's going on to come along. The next meeting is on Wednesday 24th February at 7pm at the Jamberoo Bowling Club.

Finally, in my role as President, happy riding, and I look forward to talking, working and riding with many of you over the next year.

## **From the President 2009 Wrap-up**

2009 has been a good year for SCEC. My very deep thanks to each and all the committee for their commitment to and passion for SCEC. We are not a big team, and I know that at times the workload is intense, but the outcomes are worth it, and I know we all (especially me) appreciate the support of and effort put in by each other.

With a mostly unchanged committee from 2008, SCEC was able to hit the decks running in 2009 ... and everything ran quite nicely until the Rain Gods decided it was our turn for a little attention again, forcing the cancellation of our April and June competitions. Cancelling the June competition was very hard ... it would have been one of our biggest days over the last few years, with a number of higher level entries from non members. Still it was not to be and I just had to get over it !!!

Our first training day in February was well attended as was the July Clinic. We were very pleased to be able to tempt Brett Parbery to come down to teach at this clinic ... bookings for his arena filled within 24 hours of notification of the clinic. Tracy Stead also agreed to teach at the Clinic but was unfortunately unwell on the day. However we managed to shuffle her booked people into the arenas where Liz Sugar and Ros Quist were officiating, so all was not lost !!

One of the big achievements for 2009 was the finalisation of the building of our own permanent arenas. We finally sourced a fantastic person who dragged all the poles in place, then fixed them in place (drilling holes through the poles and using very long steel pins). Whilst an ongoing project, we were like proud parents when we were able to first use at least some of the arenas for our comps this year. With guidance from the Shellharbour Council grounds people and

input from various 'arena experts' we will continue to improve the surface of the arenas to provide that durable, springy grass surface so important to protecting our horses legs.

Finally I'd like to thank all those people who contribute to SCEC in so many ways. Firstly, our sponsors, without whose support we wouldn't be able to provide the prizes and trophies we do. Secondly, the volunteers on competition days, without who's unceasing and usually cheerful help and support we wouldn't be able to hold the competitions we do ... and I include Sharon and Terry Savell in this category, without whose unfailing good will (Terry drove back from THE Bathurst car race to cook for us ... a sacrifice I won't forget for a long time !!!), the judges and volunteers wouldn't get fed, and those of us who can't eat till after they have ridden wouldn't get their egg and bacon roll. Thirdly, the committee, without whom SCEC just would not be ... thank you Mary, Katherine, Leanne, Ewa, Kim, Tibby and Sally. And lastly, the members, thank you for your support and the support of your patient family, partners, friends. SCEC exists for the benefit of its members, and we appreciate the support you show us.

To the entire SCEC 'Family' all the very best for 2010 ... I hope you are much rested and reinvigorated after the festive season and ready for a very successful year.

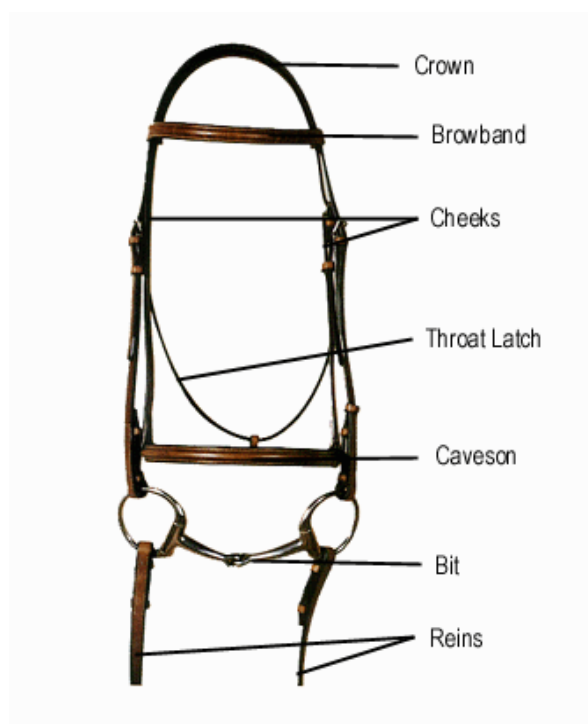

# Leather Care Do's and Don'ts

We all spend thousands of dollars on our saddles and bridles but how do we protect our investment?

Many of our saddles are made from imported leathers and require maintenance different to the Australian leather products. The most important thing to remember is that leather requires regular attention, this depends on storage, conditions it's used in and how much the horse sweats. A rough guide is a full cleaning for every 6 hours of moderate work. Cleaning leather is a multi step process! Yes there are products on the market which are 2 in 1's but these are for emergencies only or spot cleaning only!



## How to Clean a Bridle

1. Dismantle bridle fully
2. Use a mild soap like a dish washing liquid on the bit, dry off and put aside.
3. Use a saddle soap on all straps, have soap in

a film not a lather ( personally I prefer a liquid saddle soap on a soft cloth as do not need extra water).

4. Wipe off soap with a clean cloth
5. Apply leather balsam or cream with a clean cloth, pay particular attention to the back, the 'raw' side of the leather as the products will soak into this side better, rubbing the product in, following the grain of the leather and flexing the leather as you do so.
6. Once all straps are conditioned, buff with a soft clean cloth or clean soft shoe brush.
7. If excess is in the buckle holes use a blunt nail or similar to remove, and if excess on the stitching remove with a small soft brush like the shoe brush or a baby's tooth brush.
8. Wipe all buckles with a clean dry cloth
9. Re-assemble the bridle

Recommended products are the Effax range which is a German made leather care range well suited to popular bridle and saddle brands, and Bates leather Crème, which gives a lovely soft sheen finish, and gleam liquid saddle soap because it is easy!

If the bridle has brass buckles or browband, Neverdull is a great product to polish with as no excess polish will spill on the leather, do not polish the mouth piece with a metal polish unless rinsing thoroughly as may be toxic.

It is best to store the bridle in a cotton bag, and preferably without the bit on as the weight of the bit will stretch the leather.



## Saddle Cleaning

1. Take leathers and girth off the saddle
2. Use saddle soap over entire saddle top and bottom of all flaps
3. Wipe soap off with a clean soft cloth
4. If small lumps of sweat on saddle scrap off with finger nail or blunt knife.
5. Apply leather cream or balsam to entire saddle particularly underside of all leather.
6. Let sit but not in direct sunlight or heat source as will score the surface of the leather.
7. If leather is very new or stiff with age you may use a leather oil but only on the under side and not on the padded knee pads or seat as the acids in the oil will break down the glues used to secure the leather to these. Do not oil girth points or stirrup leathers as they will stretch and weaken.
8. Buff conditioner with soft cloth or clean shoe brush, pay attention to stitching or textured leather.

It is recommended to give your saddle a wipe down after every use to remove any sand, sweat etc that may be on it to avoid scratching of the surface. If ridden in the rain, at the beach etc clean straight away as salt will bleach and dry out the leather. If your saddle or bridle has mould on it from storage in damp conditions, make up a mix of 1 part white vinegar and 4 parts warm water, wipe over the leather, let dry then clean as per methods above.

Saddles should be stored on a rack above the ground in a cool dry place, away from rodents and with airflow allowed to access the panels as these can absorb a lot of sweat in contact with the horse ( even through saddlecloths) and can take a long time to dry.



It is best to clean and condition a new saddle often as this softens and protects the leather and prolongs its life and comfort, then to have to spend hours trying to make it look like new again! (And it's a great way to stick to the diet by setting up in front of the telly watching a inspirational World Champs or CDI dvd whilst polishing your gear... coz not nice trying to eat popcorn when your hands taste like leather dressing!)

8. Junior riders are 17 years and under at the time of entry. Junior riders are eligible to compete in Open, Open Pony or Junior categories but cannot compete in more than one category.
9. Associate classes are conducted under EFA Rules. Riders must be a member of the EFA at least Associate level or a member of SCEC Inc. There is no restriction on age. Horses are not required to be EFA registered and there is no restriction on height. If a horse is, or has been, graded, it may only compete at its graded level or above, or HC in a lower level.

10. Entry forms will be dated as received. If the competition is oversubscribed, entries will be entered in the draw in order of date received. Late entries will be placed on a reserve list.
11. Entries will only be accepted if the form is filled out correctly with correct payment included and the disclaimer signed. Incorrectly completed entries will be returned.
