# Presentation of Horse and rider for dressage competitions

If you have ever had a read through the rules regarding approved dressage equipment and presentation for competitions you will realize they are both involved and a little vague at the same time!

Therefore I will attempt to make things easier for you on aspects that haven't been clearly outlined.

I suggest you all refer to the link on the club website under the rules and regulations tab to see the full rules regarding bits, approved helmets, boots, whips and spurs, etc but these following points should be of help.

1. First impressions do make an impact.

A well presented horse and rider will indicate to the judge that the competitor has pride in their horse and their training, and respect for the judge's expertise and time.

2. The preferred apparel is practical (other than the light coloured jodhpurs or breeches if you are a dirt magnet like me!)

Every aspect of the clothing has a practical application, the boots and helmet are obvious safety factors, the light coloured jodhpurs and dark jacket make an appealing outline and allows the judge to see the rider's aids.

Don't forget your gloves! Gloves (white preferred) are mandatory and do help with the grip on the reins and protect them from the sun and wind! Choose gloves that are comfortable for your hands, which you can feel the reins through and that don't have seams and ridges in any place that will rub.

3. Do you go out in the morning without doing your hair?!

I doubt you would go out in public without doing your hair...the same should go for your horse. A well plaited mane and neat tail puts the final touches on the appearance of your horse.

Having the mane and forelock plaited enhances the shape of the horse's neck, as does a well trimmed and pulled tail enhances the shape of the horse's hindquarters.



4. Keep it simple!

The dressage arena is no place for mega bling..... it can distract the judge from their job of judging your performance and even make them need to pull out a pair of sunnies!

An elegant bridle with minimum decoration is preferable; it should match the size and shape of your horse's head and enhance it. A noticeable brow band can actually draw attention to any tilting and unsteadiness in the horse's head.

Saddle clothes, either shaped or square can be used and also should suit the horse, a saddle-cloth that is too large will make the horse look short in the back and like it is restricted in its movement. It can also be uncomfortable for the horse by rubbing behind the shoulder and in the flanks.

## 5. Time is precious, use it wisely!

The makeup and grooming required for the show ring isn't necessary for dressage, so instead of spending time putting on make up, chalking white socks and putting quarter marks on rumps, spend the time learning your tests and ensuring the horse is properly warmed up and that you present to the gear check Stewart and judge at your allotted time.

A bit of hoof black or oil is acceptable as are false tails if the horse needs one (as long as it contains no metal).



## 6. Be responsible for yourself.

It is the competitor's responsibility to present yourself and the horse in the correct gear. Make sure you are aware of rules regarding bits, whip length (no longer than 120cm including lash), spurs etc. The gear check Stewart is not there to correct your equipment but can disqualify you if it is incorrect! And judges will not wait for you to fix things...



## 7. No Artificial Additives thanks!

There are strict rules in place regarding the use of artificial and training aids. The use of balancing or draw reins including de gogues, chambons and pesoa's are not allowed even when lunging. Only direct side reins are allowed and a single lunge rein, failure to comply with these rules can lead to disqualification.

Running Martingales are only allowed with a snaffle bridle in the warm up arena, as are horse boots and bandages.

I know this seems a lot, and can be quite scary, but with a little thought and preparation it is easy to look smart and elegant to compete!

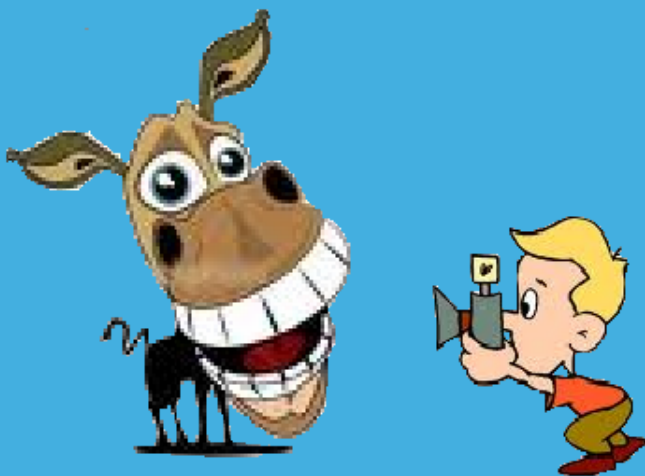
## June 2010 Comp

### **Entries close 28th July**

#### **Grading system delay**

The proposed implementation date of 01/07/2010 for the new updates to the grading system has been extended due to "IT" problems with the database.

The new expected implementation date is set for 1/12/10.

Consequently an 'amnesty' on the accruing of grading points will apply to horses, the same as it currently does for ponies as of 1/7/10 until the new grading system is implemented. Riders will still be required to keep a record of their performances for qualification purposes. In addition all horse results need to continue to be entered on the National data base but without accruing any grading points.

The reason for the above is due to the fact that there are many, many riders who have planned their competition programme around the implementation date of 1/7/10 in order to keep their horses at their current level. Another added bonus is the fact that all horses and ponies now know what their grading will be. So will the Branches and they can then work on getting new performance cards out to the riders/owners before the implementation date.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This competition will be held in accordance with EFA rules (1st January 2008). Available on [www.efanational.com](http://www.efanational.com).
2. Neither South Coast Equestrian Club, nor the owner of the grounds, accepts any liability for any accidents, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
3. Competition is open to Horses, Galloways and Ponies (including stallions). Horses may only be ridden on the grounds by the designated competitor.
4. Only horses entered in a competition are allowed on the grounds.
5. Horses may not compete in more than two consecutive levels - i.e. Prep/Preliminary; Preliminary/ Novice.
6. Riders are restricted to 3 tests per horse and a maximum of 2 horses per test.
7. Ponies are 14.2hh or less (149cm with shoes or 148cm without). Pony entries are open and there is no restriction on the age of the rider.
8. Junior riders are 17 years and under at the time of entry. Junior riders are eligible to compete in Open, Open Pony or Junior categories but cannot compete in more than one category.
9. Associate classes are conducted under EFA Rules. Riders must be a member of the EFA at least Associate level or a member of SCEC Inc. There is no restriction on age. Horses are not required to be EFA registered and there is no restriction on height. If a horse is, or has been, graded, it may only compete at its graded level or above, or HC in a lower level.

10. Entry forms will be dated as received. If the competition is oversubscribed, entries will be entered in the draw in order of date received. Late entries will be placed on a reserve list.
11. Entries will only be accepted if the form is filled out correctly with correct payment included and the disclaimer signed. Incorrectly completed entries will be returned.
12. Copies of the tests are available through the SCEC website.
13. HC may be entered until 5 days before the competition day; once you have entered HC it will not be removed. HC entries do not receive points or prizes.
14. Scratchings will be accepted with a full refund up until 8pm on the day the entries close. No refunds after this time.
15. Draws will be sent by email where at all possible -in order to reduce the use of paper and to ensure competitors receive the draw as soon as possible. Please provide your email address if you wish to receive the draw in this way. Copies of the draw will only be provided to competitors who provide a stamped, self-addressed business sized envelope with their entries. Those who do not have email or provide a SAE may access the draw on the SCEC website – [www.southcoastequestrianclub.com.au](http://www.southcoastequestrianclub.com.au).
