# Preparing for the Change of Seasons

As I write this article I am certain I can hear a collective chorus of 'yahoo!, spring is on its way, the days are getting warmer and longer!' ( followed by auchoo! As we sneeze on the masses of coat our horses are shedding!)

So, with this in mind I will list a few things to make the transition from winter wooly bear horse to sleek summer horse a little easier.

## Rugging

The days are getting warmer and therefore the heavy doonas our horses have worn throughout winter are too hot to wear on our glorious spring days. Change to a lighter weight rug or even an unlined canvas as long as it will keep the wind out and rain if it happens suddenly. It is unhealthy for the horse to overheat and sweat, it can dehydrate them, (yes even on a mild day), it can cause fungal problems with their skin, bleach the coat with the salts in the sweat and make them hot, uncomfortable and itchy!



Maybe even use a cotton rug underneath which can be washed regularly so the loose hair which is falling out in buckets doesn't end up looking like a carpet on the inside of your rug.

NB. Don't put these rugs away yet though as you may still need to use at night for another few weeks. Dress for the conditions.



## Grooming

The best way to remove the long loose winter coat is bit by bit with a grooming session every day. This not only is enjoyable for the horse ( generally...but a bit itchy and sneezy for the groom), but it improves skin and coat condition by increasing circulation and distributes the natural oils through the coat making it shiny. Using a rubber mitt or curry comb followed by a natural bristled brush for best results, synthetic bristle brushes cause static and the hair will stick back to the horse and you.

Washing or hosing with warm water occasionally can help but by washing all the time you will wash out the natural oils and make the coat dull. It is also quite cold still really, would you like a cold shower in the open air after a run at the moment? ....I didn't think so....

Letting a horse roll in a clean sand roll after working and then brushing them clean and dry is the best for skin and coat condition.

Tip: Lightly work the horse to warm but not sweaty, then brush...it will remove lots of hair as the pores are open and the hair loosens easily. Grooming a damp horse isn't very effective so vigorously towel dry first.



## Feeding

As the warmer weather comes along be aware that the grass will start to grow again so you may need to gradually change your horse's diet.

If you are fortunate enough to have your horse on good pasture, take into account that the spring grass is fattening so you may need to cut down on your hay and chaff. ( your wallet will thank you.)



If you are like me and almost allergic to riding when its cold, wet and windy ( bad, I know) then the spring days will see an increase in your horse's work as we come out of hibernation and become riders again, more work may mean more feed to cover the extra energy used and maintain optimum condition. ( I mean the horse not you..... am sure a few kilos could be spared, so put down that chocolate bar!)

## Pest Control

Spring means the invasion of flying, biting, annoying insects for horses and riders. Start using fly masks, mesh combos and even mesh leg wraps for those horses that suffer Queensland Itch. As they say prevention is better then cure ( and a lot more comfortable for the poor horses).

Make sure manure piles are away from where the horses are housed or like to stand to ensure flies are minimal.

Ensure you keep up a regular worming routine, some parasites are borne by flying insects like onchecera (neck threadworm).



Finally enjoy the warmer weather and have fun with your horses.

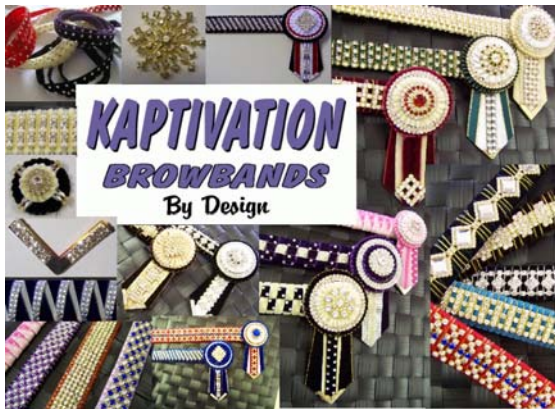

**To compete at SCEC competitions, you must be a member of SCEC Inc of the EFA.**

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This competition will be held in accordance with EFA rules (1st January 2008). Available on [www.efanational.com](http://www.efanational.com).
2. Neither South Coast Equestrian Club, nor the owner of the grounds, accepts any liability for any accidents, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
3. Competition is open to Horses, Galloways and Ponies (including stallions). Horses may only be ridden on the grounds by the designated competitor.
4. Only horses entered in a competition are allowed on the grounds.
5. Horses may not compete in more than two consecutive levels - i.e. Prep/Preliminary; Preliminary/ Novice.
6. Riders are restricted to 3 tests per horse and a maximum of 2 horses per test.
7. Ponies are 14.2hh or less (149cm with shoes or 148cm without). Pony entries are open and there is no restriction on the age of the rider.
8. Junior riders are 17 years and under at the time of entry. Junior riders are eligible to compete in Open, Open Pony or Junior categories but cannot compete in more than one category.
9. Associate classes are conducted under EFA Rules. Riders must be a member of the EFA at least Associate level or a member of SCEC Inc. There is no restriction on age. Horses are not required to be EFA registered and there is no restriction on height. If a horse is, or has been, graded, it may only compete at its graded level or above, or HC in a lower level.

10. Entry forms will be dated as received. If the competition is oversubscribed, entries will be entered in the draw in order of date received. Late entries will be placed on a reserve list.
11. Entries will only be accepted if the form is filled out correctly with correct payment included and the disclaimer signed. Incorrectly completed entries will be returned.
12. Copies of the tests are available through the SCEC website.
13. HC may be entered until 5 days before the competition day; once you have entered HC it will not be removed. HC entries do not receive points or prizes.
14. Scratchings will be accepted with a full refund up until 8pm on the day the entries close. No refunds after this time.
15. Draws will be sent by email where at all possible -in order to reduce the use of paper and to ensure competitors receive the draw as soon as possible. Please provide your email address if you wish to receive the draw in this way. Copies of the draw will only be provided to competitors who provide a stamped, self-addressed business sized envelope with their entries. Those who do not have email or provide a SAE may access the draw on the SCEC website – [www.southcoastequestrianclub.com.au](http://www.southcoastequestrianclub.com.au).

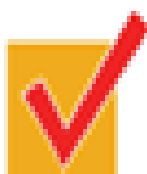
