From the President January 2011

Welcome to the first newsletter from SCEC for 2011. I'm back ... at our AGM the other day, I was fortunate enough (I think !!) to be re-elected as President for another year, and lets hope we have a good year !! We have 'lost' Mary (after 14 years on the committee she feels she needs a break !!), Kim and Caroline this year but the rest of the committee have also retained their places, and as a new addition we sincerely welcome Ebony-Lee Holz to the committee. I'm sure you will all join me in welcoming in all the new committee, and thanking them for taking on the role ... the existence of SCEC would not be possible without the (sometimes substantive) commitment of these people. To begin the year we are holding a Training Day on Sunday 27 February, a week before the first (of our 6 planned) comp for the year on Sunday

Please be aware that your committee are currently investigating utilising an online entry system. The advantage of this from our perspective is a massive saving in person hours required to receipt entries, do the draw (yes one system tells me that just 6 minutes after the event closes on the website the draw is done and emailed to the club contact. I can tell you it takes me a hell of a lot longer than 6 minutes to do a draw !!), and process payments ... and with a small committee like ours this may help relieve some committee member burn out syndrome !! More details regarding this change in process will be forwarded to members after we have assessed the available systems and made a decision.

Running competition days requires input from many people ... and we ask that all our members volunteer to help with one task or another as often as they possibly can, especially on competition days ... helping set up the grounds, penciling, collecting tests are just some of the myriad of tasks that we need help with. This year, we'll be especially encouraging the juniors to have a go at penciling ... sitting with a judge and seeing how tests flow from

their perspective is a great experience and can help a rider finesse the riding of their own tests to ensure the best possible reception from the judge. So please don't be backward in coming forward and offering to help with whatever you can.

This year SCEC committee meetings will be held on the Wednesday a week and a half before each comp – that is, the committee will meet 6 times during the year (and probably an extra at the end of the year to sort out HOTY/point score etc), rather than each month. All members are welcome and we encourage anyone who may have ideas, suggestions or just a general interest in what's going on to come along. The next meeting is on Wednesday 23rd February at 7.30pm at the Aviator Lounge, Albion Park Airport.

Finally, in my role as President, happy riding, and I look forward to talking, working and riding with many of you over the next year.

The SCEC Committee is always looking to improve our service to our members. In order to speed up the running of the competition day, especially for those who ride early and wish to leave after their class is over, we endeavour to post results as soon as it is possible.

We do however, need to rely on the good will and cooperation of competitors. Firstly we are always looking for helpers to bring the tests from the judge's cars to the scorers. The more people volunteer their help as "runners" throughout the day, the quicker the scores can be calculated.

We would also like to request that competitors who appear on the draw, but are unable to attend the competition or ride one of their tests, please advise the SCEC Committee member nominated at the bottom of the draw of their circumstances.

While it may not seem like a significant problem for the running of a competition, missing a test can greatly prolong the time it takes the scorers to post class results, as the committee have to walk around the grounds and look for missing competitors.

Competitors are also reminded that they must present for a gear check before every test, not just once a day.

We thank everyone for their cooperation in these matters, and look forward to smooth running and successful competitions in 2011.

To compete at SCEC competitions, you must be a member of SCEC Inc or the EA.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This competition will be held in accordance with EA rules (1st January 2011). Available on www.equestrian.org.au.
2. Neither South Coast Equestrian Club, nor the owner of the grounds, accepts any liability for any accidents, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
3. Competition is open to Horses, Galloways and Ponies (including stallions). Horses may only be ridden on the grounds by the designated competitor.
4. Only horses entered in a competition are allowed on the grounds.
5. Horses may not compete in more than two consecutive levels - i.e. Prep/Preliminary; Preliminary/ Novice.
6. Riders are restricted to 3 tests per horse and a maximum of 2 horses per test.
7. Ponies are 14.2hh or less (149cm with shoes or 148cm without). Pony entries are open and there is no restriction on the age of the rider.
8. Junior riders are 17 years and under at the time of entry. Junior riders are eligible to compete in Open, Open Pony or Junior categories but cannot compete in more than one category.
9. Associate classes are conducted under EA Rules. Riders must be a member of the EA at least Associate level or a member of SCEC Inc. There is no restriction on age. Horses are not required to be EA registered and there is no restriction on height. If a horse is, or has been, graded, it may only compete at its graded level or above, or HC in a lower level.

10. Entry forms will be dated as received. If the competition is oversubscribed, entries will be entered in the draw in order of date received. Late entries will be placed on a reserve list.
11. Entries will only be accepted if the form is filled out correctly with correct payment included and the disclaimer signed. Incorrectly completed entries will be returned.
12. Copies of the tests are available through the SCEC website.
13. HC may be entered until 5 days before the competition day; once you have entered HC it will not be removed. HC entries do not receive points or prizes.
14. Scratchings will be accepted with a full refund up until 8pm on the day the entries close. No refunds after this time.
15. Draws will be sent by email where at all possible - in order to reduce the use of paper and to ensure competitors receive the draw as soon as possible. Please provide your email address if you wish to receive the draw in this way. Those who do not have email may access the draw on the SCEC website - www.southcoastequestrianclub.com.au.
16. Callers are permitted.
