## From the President March 2011

Ros Quist and Robyn Targa kindly offered their services to judge tests that SCEC members wished to practice ... and as well as judging did quite a bit of 'coaching' their riders with the aim of helping them score the best points possible. If I heard this once I heard it a thousand times ... accuracy counts ... if the test says do something at B it means at B ... not 4 strides before or 4 strides after !!!

We were also extremely lucky to be able to attract Tracy Stead, a local coach, who offered to give lessons on the day. Many, including me, took advantage of this, and I have to say I think we all learnt an awful lot. I heard nothing but praise for Tracy, her style of teaching, and her ability to discern just what horse and rider needed to help them move forward. Thanks for your time and energy Tracy.

I wasn't able to be at the comp on 6 March (being in New Zealand ... working !!! ... and avoiding earthquakes !!!!) but have heard that a good day was had by all. If the results are anything to go by, there were some super tests ridden ... quite a few 70%+ scores !!!

Our next comp is on Sunday 26 April ... and yes we know that is EASTER SUNDAY !! For those who aren't going away for Easter (and who with animals gets the luxury of time away very often ??) we hope to tempt them to come out to the comp. We are planning an Easter Egg hunt (for the competitors) and an Easter Carrot hunt (for the horses). As well we will be introducing our new JACKPOT class (more details in this newsletter).

The April comp will be enterable through [globalentriesonline.com.au](http://globalentriesonline.com.au) ... you will be able to pay by credit card or by direct deposit into the SCEC bank account. Many of you will already have experience with this system as it is used by Berry Riding Club and Shoalhaven Dressage Club as well as many others. For those that have difficulty with the technology, please contact me and I will help you through it. Because it is an online system, and

computers aren't as flexible as people, it will mean that the entry close date means exactly that, entries will CLOSE at the date and time nominated !! So don't be late ... get online and enter whilst you are thinking about it !!! The good news is that we will be able to extend the closing date to closer to the comp date because the system does a lot of the work that I would have had to tediously do by hand (in my spare moments !!).

Running competition days requires input from many people ... and we ask that all our members volunteer to help with one task or another as often as they possibly can, especially on competition days ... helping set up the grounds, penciling, collecting tests are just some of the myriad of tasks that we need help with.

Finding willing volunteers is getting harder and harder. Please don't be backward in coming forward and offering to help with whatever you can. I don't want to have to get to the stage where we are unable to hold a comp or an individual class because we haven't got for example a penciller for the judge in that arena. I convinced my mother (the most non-horsey person you can possibly imagine) to come and set up lunch (beautifully and tastefully supplied by Katherine) for the judges and pencilers !! This year SCEC committee meetings will be held on the Wednesday a week and a half before each comp – that is, the committee will meet 6 times during the year (and probably an extra at the end of the year to sort out HOTY/point score etc), rather than each month. All members are welcome and we encourage anyone who may have ideas, suggestions or just a general interest in what's going on to come along. The next meeting is on Wednesday 13th April at 7.30pm at the Aviator Lounge, Albion Park Airport.

Finally, in my role as President, happy riding, and I look forward to talking, working and riding with many of you over the next year.

# New EA Stallion Safe Practise Guidelines

In the interests of public safety Equestrian Australia (EA), with the assistance of the National Sport Committees, has developed the following Stallion Safe Practise Guidelines for the management of stallions at competitions and public venues.

EA requests that all Australian events running under Equestrian Australia and FEI rules, make the use of the horse and float Stallion Identification Discs compulsory effective as of 01 January 2011 (see point 1 of the guidelines).

Equestrian Australia also recommends events and organisations adopt the following set of guidelines for the handling of stallions

Stallions should wear official 'discs' at all times whilst at the venue. These discs are to be worn on both sides of head collars and bridles or on some part of the horse on both sides to identify to others that the horse is a stallion.

No stallion is to be moved around a venue without displaying the stallion discs and a suitable restraint. The restraint can be a bridle, a rearing bit or a chain lead rein over the nose or under the jaw. Where possible all stallions are to be stabled. If suitable stabling is not available stallions need to wear a collar, which is securely tied to the outside of a truck or trailer. Stallions tied to the outside of a truck or trailer MUST be supervised at all times.

Stallions may be substituted in prize-giving ceremonies with another horse should the rider deem it to be safer. It is recommended that riders and handlers of stallions at shows be over the age of 17 years; however, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to understand the full code of conduct for stallions at events. With the exception of rule 1.1.8 in the Show Horse Rules and Guidelines, stallions are not permitted

in Show Horse classes at EA State or Championship events. All riders/handlers under the age of 17 years must be supervised by an adult/parent/guardian whilst at the event.

It is the stallion owner's/rider's responsibility to ensure that all possible safety precautions are taken. Floats/Trucks that transport stallions should display the official magnet giving notice that there is a stallion on board.

These guidelines are consistent with Equestrian Australia's focus on improving safety by identifying risks and putting in place measures to mitigate those risks.

Stallion identification packs are available for purchase from the Equestrian Australia National Office (only the approved discs will be permitted).

The packs consist of:

2 x magnets for trucks/trailers

2 x halter discs (as per point 1 of the guidelines)

2 x bridle discs (as per point 1 of the guidelines)

2 x saddlecloth discs. (As per point 1 of the

guidelines)

# The Amazing New Dressage Test For Horses Unsuitable to Become Anything

## The Test

1. A. Enter at ordinary serpentine.  
X. Sprawl. Salute.
2. C. Stop dead. Stare in horror at judge and shy to left.  
Continue at ordinary working gallop.
3. E. Stagger left 20 or 15 or 22 meters in diameter circle or pear  
shape or five pointed star. Avoid excessive crossing of legs.
4. K. Begin to halt.  
Z. Keep trying.  
F. You can do it.  
B. Pulley rein. Give up. Continue at out of hand gallop.
5. H. Regain right stirrup. Continue at ordinary trop, bouncing.
6. MKT Change rein. Free Walk loose reins. Remove horse from  
judge's luncheon table. Ask judge for leg up. Jump back into  
ring.
7. Z. Turn down centre Line.  
Halt. Grin. Scratch. Burst into tears. Leave area at free walk  
on long reins, loose language.

## History of the Amazing New Dressage Test

1995 marks the 21st birthday of The Amazing New Dressage Test (For Horses Unsuitable to Become Anything). (There used to be dressage classes "For Horses Suitable to Become a Dressage Horse" - Ed.) Almost every dressage person in the English-speaking world has giggled over this test; it has become an anonymous classic. Hardly anybody knows where it came from. Karyn Curtis and I know. We wrote it. Here's the story:

In May 1974, some Spiritwood riders went to the OADG Spring Dressage Show at Copanspin Farm (then Marchcroft, now Riverside) in Dunrobin. There was Lorraine MacDonald, with her TBX mare Baska; my employee, Big Sue MacMillan, with her 3-year-old Quarter Horse, Flyer; and me with my 5-year-old grey mare, Azteca, known to her friends as Tattie. It was our first dressage show ever in our lives -- except for Lorraine, who had been in just one. A bunch of little kids came to help; Karyn was one of them. It turned out to be The Dressage Show From Hell. The rain came down in buckets all day without stopping. The show was held in the indoor arena with no place to warm up. We were up to our knees in mud outside. The ramp of the truck got slippery. The horses went crazy and we didn't get any ribbons.

We finally got home, soaking, shivering, miserable and disgusted. The word dressage was enough to make us throw up. We all sat around the kitchen table: Lorraine, her husband Angus, Sue, me and a lot of little kids. There was also, I remember, a bottle of wine. And we got silly and we wrote The Amazing New Dressage Test to express what we had just been through

It went, anonymously, into the OADG Newsletter; then it went into the OVH Pony Club Newsletter; then the Corinthian (now Horse Sport) picked it up; then the Chronicle printed it; then , over the next ten years, it went into many regional U.S. dressage newsletters, to England, to California, back to Canada via Vancouver, and it's still traveling. Horse and Country printed it last year and, I ask you to believe, a friend sent it to me from Yellowknife, NWT, saying "Isn't this the funniest thing you ever read, who do you think wrote it?"

Do you want to know what happened to the cast of characters? Flyer was sold as a hunter/eventer and was re-named "Cashel" and, when I last heard, was still in retirement in Oxford Mills. Tattie achieved a respectable Medium 2/3 and ended her days as a school horse here at Spiritwood, teaching about a million people how to do shoulder-in. I don't know what became of Baska -- I last saw her picture in a tack ad for a Toronto store, modelling a blanket. Big Sue MacMillan went back to Edmonton and married a dairy farmer and has two children. The little kids all grew up; ponies were replaced by horses, horses by university, careers, husbands. Karyn came back to Spiritwood. I never left. Lorraine MacDonald is an FEI Dressage Judge for Canada!

So now you all know the true history of The Amazing New Dressage Test...

# New Jackpot Test



SCEC is proud to offer a new incentive to our riders.

SCEC members riding Associate classes from Preliminary to Medium levels will have the opportunity to win prize money at 4 of our competitions per year.

One test per competition will be nominated as a Jackpot test. A percentage of the total of entry fees for this test will be allocated as prize money for first to third place getters:

1st Place will receive 40% of the total of class fees  
 2nd Place 20% of the total of class fees  
 3rd Place 10% of the total of class fees

e.g. if the total of class entry fees is \$200 1st place will receive \$80; 2nd place will receive \$40; 3rd place will receive \$20.

Where there is equal place getters two riders receive the same score placing 1st to 3rd then the prize money will be divided equally between both riders.
