Kimberlee was off to be officially graded the next week, so she can compete nationally and internationally ... we wish her all the very best, and hope to see her at SCEC again soon.

And wasn't it a great day ... we had quite a few scratchings (a lot of injuries ... we hope these gees are on the up and up), but everyone was in a good mood, and the day ran smoothly and pleasantly !!

The last annual event for the club will be the SCEC AGM and Horse of the Year Presentation and dinner. As we have done for the last few years, we are avoiding the busy pre Christmas time and will hold this event mid January, Wednesday evening 16 January to be exact ... and again we have booked the Aviator Lounge at Albion Park Airport. No matter how much you love your horse, DO NOT try to free the horse yourself, people lose their own lives in such attempts.

Call the police and they will direct you to an appropriate rescue service in your area. Then call your vet. In most cases the horse will need to be sedated before any rescue efforts are undertaken.

Once the rescue team get there, follow their directions. Often an overly emotional owner can make their horse even more anxious and hinders rescue efforts.

Large Animal Rescue Seminar

Last month SCEC and Horseland hosted the first large animal rescue seminar in our area. It was presented by Australia's leading animal rescue operator Anthony Hatch. Not only was it informative but also incredibly entertaining. It was attended by horse enthusiasts and members of the local State Emergency Service.

We learned a lot about what is possible, and some unique and innovative rescue methods.



If your horse is in a rolled float, DO NOT open the door to check on him/her. Even on their side and injured the horse might be calm, opening the door will trigger a flight response and in such situations the horse will not care that it can't fit through a door or window, they will try. To keep the horse calm, put a tarp over the float and windows until help arrives.



The following is a summary of the advice for what to do/not do in horse rescue situations

If the horse is not already contained, you can help calm it down by blindfolding it. Bras are incredibly useful for this!!!



Lastly the Fire Brigade are conducting training courses for vets in rescue operations. They ask us to encourage our vets to attend these, as the assistance of a trained vet can often make a big difference to the success of a rescue.

Anthony has put an enormous amount of time and effort into starting the large animal rescue cause in Australia, as we previously did not have any organisations specialising in this. His work is far from over, and heavily reliant on sponsorships and donations. He is currently trying to raise money to buy a horse float, so that it can be modified and used in the new training courses. If you would like to help his worthy cause please contact him.
