2014 CDI Report

On Saturday May 3rd a small group of SCEC members travelled up to the annual Sydney CDI dressage competition held at the International Equestrian Centre, Horsley Park, Sydney. The weather was cold but that did not deter the crowds from gathering to watch Australia's best dressage riders and horses battling it out in the crowd favourite, freestyle to music competitions in the venue's beautiful indoor arena.

The competition held over the 3 days prior showcased the best Australia has to offer and we were lucky enough to have SCEC regular competitors competing over the weekend. Jim Collin and Southerly placed 7th in the Advanced 5.3 with 67.54% and 14th in the 5.2 with 65.43%, Kim McDonald and Warburton Regatta placed 20th in the 5.2 with 63.81%, and 29th in the 5.3 with 61.32%, while Shoalhaven local, Alycia Targa took out the 6YO Young Horse class riding Jane Bruce's CP Dresden. Well done to you all!

The 2 draw card competitions were the Intermediate Freestyle won by Southern Highlands rider (previously regular SCEC guest instructor... lets just claim him as our own!) Brett Parbury riding Good As Gold with a score of 72.46%. The Grand Prix competition went down to the wire and was decided by the last rider and crowd favourite, Heath Ryan, riding the beautiful black stallion, Regardez Moi with a score of 73.76%. It was an historic triumph for Heath who in winning the title takes the Sydney CDI Grand Prix Freestyle crown for the sixth occasion (previous wins were in 2012, 2008, 2007, 2003, 2000) which is more than any other rider. Such a great achievement!

It was not just the dressage that got us excited.....the half time entertainment was provided by some of the country's top showjumpers, which kept the normally conservative dressage crowd on the edge of their seat with plenty of oooo's, ahhhhh's and cheering as the riders made their way around the course with lots of tight turns and difficult jump combinations built in for extra excitement.

Oh and lets not forget the 'YMCA' dance competition to keep the crowd entertained and to keep us warm in the freezing conditions while show organisers transformed the arena from jumping course back to a dressage arena; SCEC secretary Leanne Micallef doing the club proud dancing up a storm (if only we had a camra).

But lets not forget the shopping! As always there was plenty of shops with great products and bargins to be had. I think its fair to say that no one went home empty handed!

It would be lovely to see more SCEC faces next year in attendance and supporting Australian Dressage at its finest, its always a great night out and enjoyed by all!
